Ingesting products</p> <p>! contact of activator/borax in eye</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Borax and/or some slime activators can be harmful to the skin, eyes and body if ingested. - Children to wear gloves when mixing slime. - SDS sheets up to date, staff know where to access. - Staff to scoop borax carefully as to keep dust to a minimum. - If a child gets borax in eye/s wash with cool water for about 1 hour and notify parents ASAP. - Staff to be stationed evenly throughout group whilst slime making is in session. - Discussion prior to slime activity around safety and using materials safely. - If materials are ingested, the child will be offered water to rinse mouth and parent will be notified as a courtesy.
